

Trinidadian food writer Lesley Enston brings us into the overlapping histories of the Caribbean islands through their rich cultures and cuisines. The widespread use of the eleven staple ingredients in **BELLY FULL** (cassava, chayote, coconut, cornmeal, okra, plantains, pumpkin, rice, salted cod, and scotch bonnet peppers) comes from the harrowing history and impact of the Atlantic Slave Trade and colonialism on the islands. The book is organized by ingredient, and we get basic knowledge on choosing, storing, and preparing these ingredients as well as a mix of traditional and creative adaptations to dishes.

Lesley Enston is a recipe developer, food writer and tester whose work has been featured in *Basically, Bon Appetit* and *Food52*. She is a home cook of Trinidadian descent and aims to highlight the diversity and beauty of Caribbean cuisine, embrace the shared histories of all the islands and how that shapes their food culture, and introduce the food of the Caribbean to home cooks everywhere.

When Sarah Fennel launched her website Broma Bakery in 2010, little did she know that 10 years later her brown butter chocolate chip cookie recipe would have more than 2.5 million views across social media! In her first cookbook, she divides 100 recipes for easy bakes into chapters like Elevated Nostalgia (Peanut Butter + Jelly Swirled Blondies), Inventive Sweets (Espresso Martini Cake), Brunch Bakes (Raspberry Croissant Bread Pudding), Almost Too Pretty (Salted Caramel Pot de Cremes), and Holiday Baking (Coconut Cake Snowballs). Her fans also love singleserve sweets, so in **SWEET TOOTH**, they get a whole chapter of them—like Molten Lava Cakes for Two and Small-Batch Blueberry Muffins. Useful, playful, and with often-times "I can't believe it was so easy!" instructions, these recipes suit beginners, pros, and anyone who has a sweet tooth.

Sarah Fennel, self-taught baker and photographer, created her online blog Broma Bakery in 2010 which now has a newsletter subscriber email list of over 150k fans. She also founded her company Foodtography where she leads food photography and food styling classes.



Through essays, interviews, and more than 100 recipes, Dr. Harris presents American cuisine as a complex braid—an interwoven whole composed of ingredients and dishes from the Indigenous, European, and African people who influenced the food and traditions of the New World. By beginning with a recipe and tracing its origins, we come to understand the heritage of some of America's most treasured dishes.

Jessica B. Harris is the author, editor, and translator of seventeen books, including twelve cookbooks documenting the foods and foodways of the African diaspora. Her IACP Award-winning book, HIGH ON THE HOG (Bloomsbury), has been adapted into a Netflix series.

UNTITLED A BOOK ABOUT BREAD by Richard Hart

In **UNTITLED A BOOK ABOUT BREAD**, Richard Hart lays out the art of baking artisanal breads using an intuitive roadmap. Rather than focusing obsessively on precise formulas and complicated shaping, Richard teaches aspiring bakers key techniques they can apply for all loaves. He also encourages them to be observant: to think about their environment (is it humid, hot, or cold?), notice their starter (how big are the bubbles?), consider the dough (is it sticky?), and pay attention to how it reacts when it's divided, shaped, scored, and baked. With a humorous and reassuring voice, **UNTITLED A BOOK ABOUT BREAD** guides readers through making 60 different loaves, including Richard's signature sourdough city loaf, pan loaves, sweet breads, flatbreads, and more, without getting overly scientific.

Richard Hart is the co-founder of Hart Bageri, with two locations in Copenhagen. Before his bread baking career, he was a chef in fine dining restaurants in London. He began baking bread seriously at Della Fattoria in California, eventually moving on to become head baker at Tartine in San Francisco, always developing his techniques and passion for his craft. Originally from England, he currently lives in Mexico City, Mexico.

Countries dealing with major conflict are rarely portrayed in a well-rounded light by the media—images of disarray and decline saturate their narratives, ignoring the strength, resourcefulness, and ingenuity that arises from having to navigate conflict. In **IN THE FIELD**, James Beard Award-winner Hawa Hassan brings us into these multi-faceted narratives for eight countries around the world: Afghanistan, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Egypt, El Salvador, Iraq, Lebanon, Liberia, and Yemen.

Each chapter is devoted to a different country and opens with an informative essay on the culture and the foodways written by a local from that area. Recipes follow highlighting indigenous ingredients and share intimate portraits of the people preserving food culture. This collection returns some agency to the people whose stories up until now have been ignored in the media and sheds light on the important work of preserving recipes and food traditions in places of conflict and migration.

Hawa Hassan is a James Beard award winner and culinary triple threat: dynamic chef, TV personality and entrepreneur. She's the founder of Basbaas, a line of sauce and condiments inspired by her home country of Somalia, a fast-growing brand that has been featured in *Forbes, The New York Times, Eater* and more.

Bëtul Tunç is a baker originally from Turkey, and the founder of the social media phenomenon Turkuaz Kitchen with more than 9 million followers across Instagram and TikTok.
